State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, Douglas Roy, of said County and State, on oath say that I am a son of Thomas Roy, who at one time owned the north half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) and the south east quarter of the north west quarter (1/4), all in section eight (8), in township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of the 5th P. M., Iowa, and that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than fifty-five years last past, residing in the immediate vicinity of said land until very recent years. That Thomas P. Edgington, who at one time had a contract from E. S. Parsons who was the same man as Eugenius S. Parsons of Eugenius S. Parsons, for the purchase of the south east quarter (1/4) of the north west quarter (1/4) of said section, did not perform his contract, as I personally know, and never acquired title to any of said land, and that said Thomas P. Edgington was never in the possession of said land or any part thereof at any time. That Milton C. Munger and M. C. Munger as the name appears in the chain of title to said real estate was one and the same man, and that James E. Hadden and James E. Hadden as the name appears in said chain of title was one and the same man, and that D. P. Roy and David Pinckney Roy was one and the same man.

That my father was in the actual, open, and adverse possession of said land from the year 1873 until he conveyed it to my brother D. P. Roy or David Pinckney Roy, and that he was in such possession of the same until his death, and that his widow and heirs were in possession until conveyed to R. C. Barcroft and W. H. Maxwell, who remained in possession until sold to Rosa E. Pace, who is yet in possession, and that no person during that time ever claimed adversely to any of said parties.
