State of Iowa, Guthrie County, SS. I, Fred Gray, of said county and state, being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with William Bell, the grantee named in a certain Warrnaty Deed dated Mar. 1, 1915, recorded in Deed Rec. 50, page 476 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that prior to the date of said deed, said William Bell lived in Guthrie and Audubon Counties. That personal taxes assessed against Wm. Bell, South Township for the years 1898 and 1897 for \$0.60 and \$2.50 respectively Crawford Township 1899. \$0.50 South Township. 1900 and 1901 for \$0.50 and \$0.50 respectively. Penn Township 1902, for \$1.61 and Winterset for 1909 and 1910 for \$2.50 and \$1.50 respectively. against Wm. M. Bell, Lincoln Township for the years 1891 and 1892 for \$6.76 and \$4.44 respectively, against W. L. Bell, Scott Township for the year 1890 for \$6.46, Lincoln Township for the years 1893 and 1894 for \$4.64 and \$5.71, respectively, and Scott Township for the years 1895, 1897, and 1899 for \$2.95, \$0.80 and \$0.50 respectively, and South Township for the 1897 for \$2.50 were assessed against some person other than said grantee, William Bell; that he never lived in any of said townships or towns or had property therein subject to taxation.

I further state that the personal taxes assessed against Fred Gray in Winterset for the years 1903, 1904, 1905, 1907, 1909, and 1915 amounting to \$0.50, \$0.50, \$3.50, \$0.92, \$0.72 and \$1.01 respectively, and in Lincoln Township for the year 1916 amounting to \$4.00 are against some other person than this affiant; that the personal taxes assessed against F. E. Gray in East Peru for the years 1913, and 1914 in the sum of \$4.91 and \$4.94, respectively are against some other person than this affiant; that I never lived in either Lincoln Township, Winterset, or East Peru, Iowa, during any of said years or had personal property therein during such time subject to taxation.
