Taylor who executed a mortgage on E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ 5-75-26, to Nancy J. Brown, dated Moh 11th 1868, calling for \$610, as evidenced by three notes. That I, the said mortgagor, paid each of said notes in full, prior to June 29th, 1869, and received the same from the then owner and holder thereof; together with the mortgage securing the same; and that said debt was fully paid and satisfied. That the said notes secured by said mortgage have been since lost, and that the said Nancy J. Brown is now dead, but that the said notes were paid by me and in my possession and fully redeemed when lost. That I received the note and mortgage securing the same from W. W.
