Dorrell, on oath say that I have been continuously a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than seventy years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with Jesse P. Shepherd who on or about the 14th day of April A. D. 1856, purchased from Samuel Guye the following described tract of land; commencing at the north east corner of the south east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section seven (7), in township seventy six (76) north, of range twenty seven (27), west of the fifth P. M. Iowa, running thence west one hundred and fifty nine (159) rods, thence south eight and one half ( $80\frac{1}{2}$ ) rods, thence east one hundred and fifty nine (159) rods, thence north eight and one half ( $80\frac{1}{2}$ ) rods to the place of beginning, and that he was the same and identical man as the J. P. Shepherd who on or about the twenty third day of May A. D. 1857, conveyed the same property to Thomas Lashbrook. W. G. Dorrell.
