Shriver, of said county and state on oath say that I have been engaged in the real estate business in Winterset, Iowa, since prior to January 1, 1906; that during all of that time I have been acquainted with the North Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) except a strip one rod wide off the West end thereof, and the North East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seven (7), in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the Fifth P. M. Iowa, and have been acquainted with the conveyance of said land; that the reference in the deed of said real estate from J. H. DeBolt and wife to T. G. White, dated on or about May 25, 1907, to a deeded road through said land refers to a strip one rods wide off the West end thereof which was at that time used for a road. That the reference in a deed from T. G. White and wife to Emma D. Sterman dated on or about May 29, 1907 to a private road running through said land, refers to the strip one rod wide off the West end of the North Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) above referred to, and that the reference in the deed from Emma D.
