State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I W.H.Deardorff, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as William H.Deardorff to whom the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ 23-74-27 was conveyed on July 22nd, 1875 by John Deardorff, to whom the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ 23-74-27 was conveyed on May 21st 1884 by Sarah Deardorff and Jacob Deardorff, to whom the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 22-74-27 was conveyed on December 2nd, 1884 by Clara A. Dodge to whom the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 22-74-27 was conveyed on June 12th, 1884 by Martha S. Howe by John A. Richards her attorney in fact and to whom the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 23-74-27 was conveyed on May 24th, 1884 by John Priest and wife; and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Empson H.Venard to whom the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ 23-74-27 was conveyed on August 19th, 1854 and well and personally know that he is the same and identical person who afterwards conveyed the said land to John Deardorff Sr., and Jacob Deardorff under the name of E.H.Venard; that I was well and personally acquainted with the said John Deardorff Sr., and well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as John Deardorff who conveyed the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 23-74-27 and other lands to Sarah Deardorff on June 12th, 1874; that I was well and personally acquainted with John Deardorff on July 22nd, 1875 when he conveyed the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 23-74-27 to myself and well and personally know that at that date he was an unmarried man; that I was well and personally acquainted with Sarah Deardorff and Jacob Deardorff who on May 21st, 1884 conveyed the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 23-74-27 to myself and well and personally know that the said Sarah Deardorff and Jacob Deardorff were husband and wife on said date, and I further depose and say that I was personally acquainted with the family of Joseph B Burdick who conveyed the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 23-74-27 to Empson H.Venard on August 19th, 1854 and that to my personal knowledge the said Joseph B. Burdick was the same person as Joseph B. Burdick to whom said land was conveyed on November 1st 1854.
