Atlantic, Iowa March 13, 1918, To whom it may concern; This is to certify that at the General election held in November 1914 James Sorenson was elected a Justice of the Peace in Brighton township in and for Cass county, Iowa, and that on December 17, 1914 the said James Sorenson qualified for said office of Justice of the Peace for the term of two years beginning January 1 1915 and held the said office for the entire term of the years of 1915 and 1916. At the General election held in November 1916 the said James Sorenson was again elected a Justice of the Peace in and for Cass county, Iowa, and on the 23rd day of December 1916 he qualified for the said office of Justice of the Peace for the term of two years beginning January 1st, 1917, and has from that time to this date continuously held said office.
