I, V.L.Callison, of Madison County, Iowa, on oath say that I was a brother-in-law of John D.Bullock, one of the grantees in a conveyance from John Bullock and wife, Elisabeth Bullock of ten (10) acres off of the south side of the southeast quarter (1/4) of the south west (1/2) of Section Three (3), in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the Fifth P.M. Iowa, dated on or about April 2, 1858; that said John Bullock and wife, Elisabeth Bullock, were the father and mother of John D. Bullock, and they are both long since dead; that Milton Bullock, a son of said John Bullock and Elisabeth Bullock, has been dead for many years, dying about the year 1865 and that during his life time, Manville Bullock and John D. Bullock supported and maintained him. That Manville Bullock was in possession and occupancy of said real estate for thirty-five years prior to his death; and that thereafter his son, and only heir, Elbert Bullock, was in possession of said real estate, until I purchased the same in the year 1908; and that during all of that time no person made any claim to any part of the said real estate adverse to the said Manville Bullock, Elbert Bullock, or myself.
