State of Ohio Ross County SS:- I, Theresa Morrison, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a daughter of Francis Hanks, who was the patentee of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 14-76-26, as shown by the records of Madison County, Iowa, and know that he was the same and identical person as the Frank Haver Hanks whose will was duly admitted to probate in Ross County, Ohio, on December 9<sup>th</sup> 1870, a certified copy of said will being filed in Madison County Iowa, on January 17<sup>th</sup> 1876 and recorded in Miscellaneous Record / page 588, of the records of said county.

I further depose and say that the Thesia Hanks, or Thresia Hanks, named in said will as the wife and devisee of said decedent was the same and identical person as the Theresa Hanks (her correct name being Thresa Hanks) who subsequently conveyed the above described real estate to James Gillespie by deed dated August 17<sup>th</sup> 1883 and recorded in Deed Record 21, page 82, of the records of Madison County, Iowa; and that the said Theresa Hanks never remarried after the death of my father.
