State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I,A.J.Rollstin,being duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am a resident of Madison County,Iowa; that I was well and personally acquainted with James M.Watson who acquired title to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 21-75-27,and other land,on the 26th day of September 1853,as shown by deed record "D" page 47 of the records of Madison County,Iowa, and also well and personally acquainted with the said James M,Watson on September 18th 1854 when he,together with his wife, Ann,executed a deed conveying the above

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described land to one Lewis Harley, as shown by deed record "A" page 433 and know that the James M. Watson, grantee in said former deed, and J.M. Watson, grantor in said latter deed, were one and the same identical person.

That I was well and personally acquainted with Hugh James Lorimor, one of the grantees in a deed conveying the above described land, on the 8th day of June 1857, as shown by Deed record "H" page 13, and also acquainted with him when he executed the deed of conveyance conveying the Undivided one-half of the above described land, as shown by deed record "H" page 110 to John Lorimor, and know that the H.J. Lorimor, grantee in the former deed, and Hugh James Lorimor, grantor in latter deed, were one and the same identical person, and that the said Hugh James Lorimor was a single and unmarried man on the 23rd, day of July 1857 when he executed said deed to John Lorimor; that whenever the name Lorimor is spelled "Larimor, Larimer" it is a mistake, the true name being Lorimor.

That I was well and personally acquainted with J.S. Holmes on the 3rd day of April 1879 when he acquired title to the above described land in deed recorded in deed record 14 page 188, also on the 23rd day of December 1879 when he, together with his wife, Elisabeth, executed a deed to myself conveying the above described land, as shown by deed record 14 page 221, and know that the J.S. Holmes, grantee in former deed, and I.S. Holmes, grantor in latter deed, were one and the same person, and that J.S. Holmes and Elisabeth Holmes were husband and wife on Dec 23rd. 1879. Further deponent sayeth not. A.J. Rollstin
