State of Iowa Madison County SS I.J.E.Hamilton of the county and state aforesaid being duly sworn on oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John A.Adamson to whom John Ballinger and wife executed a warranty deed February 15th.1870 and recorded in Deed Record 9 page 586,conveying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 1-74-28,and that the grantee's name was spelled John B.Admanson, but that the same was an error of the scrivener in drawing said deed and that his proper name was John B.Adamson.

I further depose and say that he is the same person as John B.Adamson who with his wife Mary Adamson executed a deed to Porter E.Tomlinson January 10th,1891,and recorded in Deed Record 30 page 550 of the records of Madison County,Iowa,conveying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 1-74-28.

I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with D.M.Tomlinson,grantee in a certain deed of conveyance from Porter E.Tomlinson and wife,Susan E. Tomlinson dated January 27th,1891 and recorded in Deed Record 30 page 551 conveying the above described land and that he is the same identical person as David M.Tomlinson who with his wife,Juda Tomlinson executed a deed to J.F.Tomlinson conveying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 1-74-28 December 21st 1896 and recorded in Deed Record 37 page 156 of the records of Madison County,Iowa,and that the said D.M.Tomlinson and David M. Tomlinson are both one and the same person.Further deponent sayeth not.
