State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, Urilla Lee of said state and county, being first duly sworn upon my oath, depose and say that I am the widow of C. P. Lee to whom Hugh McCully and wife, conveyed the North Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-one (31) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P. M., by deed dated March 14th, 1857, and recorded on page 270 of Deed Record "H" of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that on or about May 10th, 1858, M. C. Munger obtained a judgment against my husband, C. P. Lee, for \$111.00 as shown by Judgment Docket A, page 91, of the records in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of said county, and under the execution issued on the foregoing judgment the Sheriff of said county, sold the above described real estate to John McAndrew for Asro Patterson on or about March 10th, 1860, but no Sheriff's deed was ever issued in pursuance of said sale, as said judgment was fully settled within the time allowed for redemption, and neither the said John McAndrew or Asro Patterson ever asserted or claimed any right, title or interest in or to the real estate above described.

I have no interest whatever in the land above described. Urilla Lee.
