State of Iowa, Madison County, SS: I, J.W.Gentry, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Elizabeth J.Gentry who died seized in fee of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 17-75-28, except that part thereof lying North and West of Middle River, and I well and personally know that the said Elizabeth J.Gentry died intestate on or about the 10th day of August A.D. 1881 leaving as her husband Joshua Gentry and as her sole and only heirs at law D.E.Hogue, D.M.Gentry, John H.Gentry and J.W.Gentry, and I further depose and say that the estate of the said Elizabeth J.Gentry was never administered upon but that her estate has long since been fully settled and all claims paid in full, and I further depose and say that Elizabeth J.Gentry who died seized of said land is the same and identical person as Elizabeth J.Gentry to whom Joshua Gentry conveyed said land on August 20th, 1880 and that the said Elizabeth J.Gentry and Joshua Gentry were husband and wife on August 20th, 1880 at which time the said Joshua Gentry conveyed said land to the said Elizabeth J.Gentry.
