That I was well and personally acquainted with each of the parties hereinafter named and have personal knowledge of the facts herein set forth.

That the James Kale (who was my father), Mary A. Kale, Elizabeth J. Kale, Perce Ellen Kale, Joseph B. Kale, Emma Kale, Susannah Kale, Barbary Kale, Drusilla Kale, and John R. Kale as shown by the Registry of Heirs filed in the Estate of my said grand father John R. Kale, were all and his only children and heirs at law and Elisa Kale named in said Registry of Heirs was his widow, who after the death of her said husband John R. Kale married one, Isaac Allen.
