Blush who was the grantee in a deed from Joseph Brinson and wife Ann M. Brinson dated Jan'y 26th, 1871, conveying North East Quarter of South East Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) in Section 21, Township 75 North, of Range 28 West of the 5th P.M. and other land, and that I well and personally know that she is the same and identical person as the Francis C. Blush, who, the records of Madison county, Iowa, show, conveyed said land to Johnathan White by deed dated Feb'y 28th 1872, and that at the date of the execution of said last described deed she was an unmarried person, and so represented herself, her husband having died.
