State of Iowa Linn County, SS. I, Pearson Hall being first duly affirmed on my affirmation do state; that I was well and personally acquainted with Nathan P. Hall, who entered and received patent to the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6) Township Seventy seven (77) North, Range Twenty nine (29) west of the fifth P.M. Iowa, that the said Nathan P. Hall departed this life in the year A.D. 1867, intestate and leaving surviving him Merab Hall, his widow, and Wilson Hall, Charles P. Hall, Israel Hall, John C. Hall, Isaac Hall, Joseph Hall and Rachel Hall as his only surviving children, and Sina W. Hall, Pearson Hall, Henry Hall, Anna Mary Hall, Rachel M. Hall and Nathan P. Hall children of Jesse Hall, deceased (the said Jesse Hall being a son of the said Nathan P. Hall and that he died prior to the death of his father Nathan P. Hall), and the said Nathan P. Hall, deceased left no issue of a deceased child surviving him, other than those above named as children of Jesse Hall, deceased, and that he had no adopted children.
