State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I, A.L.Stout, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon oath, depose and say;- That I was personally and well acquainted with Samuel A.Haymond, son of George W.Haymond who died seized of the South East Quarter (1/4) of the North East Quarter (1/4) of Section Two (2) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M., and with the family of the Samuel A.Haymond that said Samuel A.Haymond was killed in an accident at his farm in Madison County, Iowa on or about the 21st day of October, A.D. 1907 and left surviving him no widow and four children, to-wit;- Earl Haymond, Lida Haymond, (now Lida Jessup wife of Darwin Jessup), Carl Haymond and Opal Haymond; that the said Earl Haymond was the same and identical person as the R.E.Haymond named as Defendant in the partition suit in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa wherein John Haymond was Plaintiff and George Haymond and others were Defendants and in which petition was filed on January 29th, 1916 and in which I was appointed and acted as sole referee and also the said Earl Haymond was the same and identical person as the R.E.Haymond named as Defendant in an action in said Court wherein The Winterset Savings Bank was Plaintiff and in which a petition was filed March 30th, A.D. 1916 and the said Defendant's interest in the real estate above described was levied on under a writ of attachment and in which judgment was rendered October 21st, 1916 for \$ 106.35 and costs against said Defendant and which judgment I, as referee, under orders of the said Court, paid the money in my hands belonging to said R.E.Haymond or Earl Haymond over to the Clerk of said Court to apply on.

All of which is true as I verily believe. A.L.Stout.
