Elsbury, of said state and county, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say, that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa for years, and that I was the same William N. Elsbury who conveyed to Johnathan Wislyler, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23 Township 74 Range 28 West of 5th P.M. by deed dated March 21st 1859, recorded book L, ^{at} page 99. That I well and personally knew the said grantee and know him to be the same and identical person as Jonathan Wissler, who, his wife joining, conveyed the land so acquired to Adam C. Krell by deed dated June 12th, 1869 and recorded book 2 at page 206 of the records of Madison County, Iowa. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with E. I. Boling who was the grantee in a deed from said Adam C. Krell bearing date of September 19th, 1870, recorded book 4 at page 76, and with that Edward L. Boling who was the grantee in a deed dated June 28th, 1873, recorded book 8 page 398; and well and personally know that they were the same and identical person, and identical with E. L. Boling ^{the grantee in a deed from E. I. Boling} dated September 1st, 1881 recorded book 19 page 538, and with Edward L. Boling, who conveyed the land so acquired, to W. S. Boling, by deed dated March 10th, 1894 recorded book 35 at page 455; in other words, that the said E. L. Boling and Edward L. Boling are one and the same identical person. I am in no way interested. Further deponent saith not.
