State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I, W.G.Dorrell, of said County and State, on oath say that I was acquainted with John Hinkle to whom Hogan Queen and wife on or about October 22nd, 1855, conveyed the south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirteen (13), in township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty seven (27) west of the fifth P.M., Iowa, and that he was the same and identical man as John Henkle who on or about the eighth day of May A.D. 1862, conveyed the same real estate to W.S. Mudgett, his name appearing in the record as W.S. Mudge.

That I was acquainted with Hogan Queen above mentioned, who died testate in Madison County Iowa, about February 19th, 1890; that W.H. Queen, Phebe J. Summers, and J.L. Queen named as grantors and T.H. Queen named as grantee in a conveyance of the west half of the north east quarter, the north west quarter of the south east quarter, and the east half of the east half of the north west quarter of section thirteen in said township and range, dated April 22nd, 1891, were the same and identical persons as William H. Queen, Phebe Jane Jones, John L. Queen, and Thomas H. Queen respectively, named in the last will of said Hogan Queen.

That I have known all of the persons above named and the facts stated above are true. That I lived within two miles of said parties for thirty years, and worked, and worked for said Queen for two years,
