State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I, J.M.Gordon of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say;- That I was personally and well acquainted with Alexander H. Lewis, to whom was patented the N.E. 1/4 S.E. 1/4 and S 1/4 NE 1/4 33-75-26 and know that he died about 1870 and left surviving him Sarah M. Lewis, his widow, Eugene L. Lewis, Alex H. Lewis, Kate L. Lewis and William H. Lewis as his sole and only heirs at law; that I was personally and well acquainted with the said William H. Lewis, son of the said Alexander H. Lewis, and know that he died prior to April 1st A.D. 1881, and that at the time of his death he was an unmarried man and that he died without issue; That he died intestate and his estate was never probated. That he died leaving no debts, except possibly some ^{small} items of debt which were fully paid by his surviving heirs; his sole and only surviving heirs being the identical persons named above as the heirs at law of Alexander H. Lewis.
