State of Iowa Warren County SS:- I.George Stiffler, of said County and State, on oath say that I am a son of Adam Stiffler to whom conveyances appear of record in the office of the recorder of Madison County, Iowa, to the following described tract; commencing at the north east corner of the south east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty four (34), in township seventy six (76) north, of range twenty six (26) west of the Fifth P.M. Iowa, running thence west eighty rods, thence south eighty rods, thence east forty rods, thence north forty rods, thence east forty rods, thence north forty rods to the place of beginning, said conveyances being made in the year 1864; that as a matter of fact said Adam Stiffler did not own and did not purchase said real estate; that said description is an error; that neither did George Stiffler Sen., to whom a conveyance of said land in 1866 appears of record in Madison County, Iowa, own said land, or claim the same; that said George Stiffler Sen. owned land south of said land, and the same was afterwards acquired by my father Adam Stiffler, but said land was not in the township and range above described which is commonly known as Crawford township and that neither said George Stiffler Sen nor Adam Stiffler was ever in possession of said land to my knowledge and neither of them made any claim thereto, or had any title thereto and said description in said conveyances result from a misdescription only.
