State of Iowa Madison County SS:- I, Catharine Bean of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for 65 years last past.

That I am a daughter of John C. Johnston who died seized of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, in Township 74 North of Range 26 West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, that the John Johnson who entered and to whom said land was patented was in fact my said father, John C. Johnston, his name having been erroneously written in the Original Entry and Patent

That said John C. Johnston died about the year 1865, leaving no widow surviving, and as his only children and heirs at law Lorinda Johnston, Catharine Johnston, Henrietta Johnston, Eliza Johnston, Nancy E. Johnston, Jehu M. Johnston, Alexander Johnston, Ocala A. Johnston and Julia E. Peter. That said Lorinda Johnston is the same and identical person as the Lorinda Johnston named in the Registry of Heirs filed in the proceedings had in the Matter of the Estate of my said father and as the Lorinda Johnston named in the Equity Proceedings brought by said Julia E. Peter in the March Term, 1866, in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa.

That said Catharine Johnston is the same and identical person as the Catherine (or Catharine) Johnston named in the Estate and Equity Proceedings above referred to.

That said Henrietta Johnston is the same and identical person as the Henrette Johnston named in said Registry of Heirs.

That Nancy E. Johnston above named is the same person as the Angeline (or Angeline G.) Johnston named in the probate proceedings had in said Estate, and the same person as the Nancy ^{Eller} Johnston named in said Equity Proceedings.

That Ocala A. Johnston above named died sometime during the year 1863 interstate, unmarried and without issue. That Julia E. Peter above named is the same and identical person as the Julia E. Peters named in said Registry of Heirs. I further state that I have no interest in the title to the land above described, but make this affidavit from personal knowledge of the facts for the purpose of correcting errors in the records of said Madison County, Iowa.
