State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, H.W.Benson of said County and State, being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County for 40 years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with James S. Larimore, who received a deed of conveyance for the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 12-74-27 & W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 30-75-27 and SW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 31-75-27 from Benjamin Lorimor, which was recorded in Deed Rec. 6, page 480 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and know of my own personal knowledge that said James S. Larimore was the same and identical person as the J. S. Larimore, grantee in a certain tax deed for the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 30-75-27; SW $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 30-75-27 & NE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  & NW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 31-75-27 and SW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section 31, Township 75, Range 27, which was recorded in Tax Deed Rec. 1, page 72; that he is also the same and identical person as the J. S. Lorimor, Plaintiff in a certain action had in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, being #482, Equity, and wherein Benjamin Lorimor and Jennett Lorimore were Defendants, quieting the title to the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the SW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 31-75-27, and other land; that he is also the same and identical person as the J. S. Larimore, grantee in a certain commissioner's deed for the land described in Deed recorded in Deed Record 6, page 480 above, which was recorded in Deed Rec. 5, page 443 of said records; that he is also the same and identical person as the James S. Lorimor, who, together, with his wife executed a certain Warranty Deed (their names appearing the deed as James S. Lorimer and Mary J. Lorimer) to Commodore A. Smith for the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 31, SW $\frac{1}{2}$  & SW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and S $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  & W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 30, all in 75-27, which is recorded in Deed Record 35, page 234 of said records, his full, true and correct name being James S. Lorimor; the name Lorimor appearing spelled other than "Lorimor" in the records of Madison County, Iowa, being an error.

That the said James S. Lorimor was my wife's father.
