Know all men by these presents; That I ,A.E.Evans of the County of Madison State of Iowa do by these presents make, constitute and appoint D,L.Evans of the County of Madison and State of Iowa my true and lawful attorney, for me, and in my place and stead to take charge of all live stock, implements, moneys and credits, and all other property of every kind, to buy sell and exchange the same receive payment therefor execute release check, and all other papers of any kind that may be necessary or proper, in caring for, disposing of, or converting into money my property, or in buying other property in lieu thereof, to buy feed, and to do all other acts that may be proper in caring for and handling my property as in his judgment is best. Giving and granting unto my attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatever required, and necessary to be done in and about the premises as fully as I might or could do if personally present, reserving the right to revoke this Power at pleasure; and I hereby ratify and confirm all that my said Attorney may lawfully do in the said premises by virtue hereof.
