State of Iowa, Madison County SS; I, W.G.Dorrell of said County and State, being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously for more than seventy years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with John M.Evens who entered and to whom was patented the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec.19-76-27 as shown by the Original Entry Book of Madison County, Iowa, and know of my own personal knowledge that said John M.Evens was the same and identical person as the John M.Evens who conveyed to Wm.Butler the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section, Township and Range, by deed of conveyance recorded in Deed Record "G", page 226 of the records of said Madison County.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with Bessie Shepherd, grantee in a certain Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "U", page 184 of said records, which deed was made by Thomas Stevens and wife and conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec.19-75-26, and know of my own personal knowledge that said Bessie Shepherd was the same and identical person as the B.L.Sherpherd, who, together with his wife, conveyed said land to Isaac Collins by deed of conveyance
