State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I, W.G.Dorrell on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, since in the year 1846 That for the first fifteen years of that time I resided within two or three miles of the northwest quarter (¼) of the north west quarter (¼) of section thirteen (13), township seventy-four (74) north, of range twenty-seven (27) west of the Fifth P.M. Iowa. That I was ^{never} personally acquainted with Sabert T.Sollers, who on or about January tenth, 1853, conveyed to Erastus S. Jones said real estate, and that my recollection and belief is that he was a non-resident of the State of Iowa, but that as I remember and believe, she was the same and identical man as Saben T.Solars, who entered said land and to whom the same was patented, and that the variation in spelling of his name simply ocured through a clerical error.
