Miller, who died in Jasper County, Iowa, about the year 1864, seized of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 32-74-24. That said Harvel B. Miller died unmarried and without issue; that he left no will and that his estate has long since been fully settled.

I further depose and say that said Harvel B. Miller left as his sole and only heirs at law, the following named brothers and sisters: - Mary Shannon; Eleanor Vance, intermarried with James Vance; William B. Miller; Frances Cordell, intermarried with Alexander Cordell; John W. Miller, whose wife's name was Louisa A. Miller; Elisabeth B. Kemper, intermarried with James W. Kemper; Charles G. Miller; Isabel Miller; and Nancy Brown, (mother of this affiant) intermarried with Jacob C.
