State of Iowa Madison County SS;- I M.L.Silliman, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do upon my oath, depose and say that I have been a resident of said county for more than 50 years last past. That during that time I have been well and personally acquainted with the ownership of the North Half (1/2) of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) and two (2) acres described as follows; Commencing at the Southeast corner of the North Half (1/2) of the Northwest Quarter (1/4), running thence South forty (40) rods, thence West eight (8) rods, thence North forty (40) rods, thence East eight (8) rods to the place of beginning; and twenty (20) acres described as follows; all that part of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) lying South and West of a line drawn diagonally from the Northwest corner thereof to the Southeast corner thereof; all of said land lying and being in Section Fourteen (14), in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.M., and well and personally acquainted with Abigail V. Quick, who, on Aug 15th, 1907, conveyed said land to Charles A. Quick, by deed recorded in Deed Record 48, at page 294 thereof, in which deed said Abigail V. Quick reserved a life estate in said land, and I further depose and say that to my personal knowledge, the said Abigail V. Quick is now dead, having died on or about the year A.D. 1916. That I am in no way interested and make this affidavit to establish of record the facts as set forth.
