Dorrell, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than seventy years last past, residing during the earlier part of my residence in Madison County, Iowa, within about two miles of the north west fractional quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section six (6) in township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty seven (27) west of the Fifth P.M., Iowa, that Taylor Hancock and Lucinda Hancock, whose names appear as grantees in a conveyance of said real estate from Mark Patterson dated on or about January 13th, 1862, were in fact Taylor Hancock and Lucinda Hancock, the name being through some clerical error misspelled. That I had no personal acquaintance with said parties but such was my understanding and general information in the neighborhood.
