State of Iowa, Madison County, SS.I, F.R.Porter of said County and State being sworn depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with J.C.Porter, who is named as grantee in the deed recorded in Deed Record 8 at page 182 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa. Said deed conveying to him Lots 11 and 12 in Block 9 in the Town of Truro, Madison County, Iowa. And Nancy E.Porter, who at one time owned said Lots and who conveyed said Lots to Thomas Huffman by the deed recorded in Deed Record 15 at page 571 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa.

That the S.Porter or Samuel Porter and Ed Porter of Grand River and, Monroe Township, Madison County, Iowa, against whom certain taxes were assessed are in no way related to the said J.C.Porter or Nancy E.Porter, and the said S.Porter, Samuel Porter and Ed Porter never had any interest in Lots 11 and 12 in Block 9 of the Town of Truro, Madison County, Iowa, and said taxes are not now, and never were a lien or charge against said property. That neither J.C.Porter or Nancy E.Porter or any of their heirs at law ever resided in Grand River Township, or Monroe Township of Madison County, Iowa, and were never assessed therein. That there was a family of Porter's who for many years resided in Grand River Township, Madison County, Iowa, but they were in no manner related to the said J.C.Porter or the said Nancy E. Porter who formerly owned the property hereinbefore described.
