State of Iowa Madison County, SS: I, Edward Haney, being first duly sworn, depose and state as follows:-That I am the person who on March 1st, 1910, acquired title by warranty deed from J.M. Gibson and wife to the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Five, and the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Eight, and Commencing at the Southeast corner of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Eight, and running thence North 2640 feet to the Northeast corner of said eighty acre tract, thence West 20 feet to the center of the highway as now used and established, thence in a southwesterly direction to a point 70 feet West of the place of beginning, thence East to the place of beginning; all in Township Seventy-five North, of Range Twenty-eight West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, as is shown by Deed Record 49 page 515 of Madison County, Iowa.

That the school lot or school house site referred to and excepted from the description in the deed from John P. Allison as receiver etc. to John T. Gaunt, dated January 6th, 1900 and recorded in Deed Record 31 page 485 of Madison County, Iowa, is not located on any part of the above described real estate, which I owned for a number of years.
