State of Iowa County of Madison SS:I,R.B.Pace of Madison County,Iowa,being first duly sworn depose and on my oath say:- That Thomas Pace,who is named as grantee in a certain deed dated June 15,1889 and filed on July 18,1889,and recorded in Deed Record 28 on page 1 of the Deed Records of Madison County,Iowa,was my grandfather;That I know of my personal knowledge that he died intestate in Madison County,Iowa,about the year 1898; that he left surviving him as his only heirs at law George C.Pace,my father,William P.Pace and Elisabeth Ward;that Elisabeth Ward and George C.Pace the grantors in a quit claim deed made to R.A. Schwaner,December 16,1909 and filed for record on March 2,1910,and recorded in deed record 39 on page 464 of the Deed Records of Madison County,Iowa,and the William P.Pace,who was the grantee in a certain quit claim deed to R.A.Schwaner,dated February 11,1910,and filed for record March 2,1910,and recorded in deed record 39 on page 465 of the Deed Records of Madison County,Iowa,were the only heirs at law of Thomas Pace,deceased.
