I, James Parker, do hereby certify that I am Secretary of the Security Loan & Investment Co. which Company is the successor to the business of the Security Loan and Trust Company both of Des Moines, Ia, and which company has in its possession all of the books and records of the said Security Loan and Trust Company which latter corporation is not now in existence and I further certify that the records of said Security Loan and Trust Company show that Section 11 of the By-laws in as follows:-

"Debentures and instruments required to be executed by the Company which affect the title to real estate shall be executed by the President and Secretary or by the President and Treasurer except releases of mortgages which may be executed by the President, Vice President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, or Assistant Treasurer".
