Houlette by deed dated January 21st, 1878, the South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty (20) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28), and I personally know that the said Charles Plamer is the same and identical person as Chalers Palmer, grantee in a deed from L.L.
