State of Iowa Madison County, SS: I, F.M. McDaniel, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with John H. Leach and Margaret Leach who conveyed the S¹/₂ NE¹/₄ Sec. 2-76-28 to William H. Alexander by deed dated February 23rd 1865 and recorded in Record "Q", page 52, and know that the said John H. Leach and Margaret Leach were husband and wife on the date said deed was executed; also, that the said John H. Leach was the same person as the John Leach to whom said land was devised by the will of Abraham Leach recorded in Will Record "A", page 77.

I further depose and say that the William H. Alexander and Franey Alexander who conveyed said land to Edward Bennett by deed dated April 10th 1869 and recorded in Deed Record 1, page 462, were husband and wife on the date said deed was executed, also, that the I.W. Clark named as grantee in a certain deed dated July 17th 1913 and recorded in Deed Record 50, page 272, was the same and identical person as the Ivor W. Clark named as grantor in a certain deed dated September 6th 1913 and recorded in Deed Record 54, page 96.

All the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
