J. Rankin my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my place and stead to make and sign any and all papers of any kind and character whatsoever for me the same as though I were present in person, and to transact and conduct any and all business for me the same as though I were present in person. This power of attorney to remain in full force and effect until revoked by me in writing.
