State of Iowa Madison County, SS. I, M.D. Hill, being first duly affirmed depose and say that I was personally acquainted with Stephen H. Hockett and Mary Hockett, his wife, I further state I was personally acquainted with Israel Compton, Justice of the Peace, who drew and acknowledged a certain warranty Deed dated Sept 7, 1872 and recorded in Madison County Record Book # 7, Page 12, and afterwards recorded in Madison County Record Book # 60, Page 329; and that the said Israel Compton in filling out said Warranty Deed spelled the name Hockett as Hockett and that further he filled in the face of the deed Stephen H. Hockett and Mary Hook, his wife and I certify this is an error and that Mary Hook mentioned in the face of the deed is Mary Hockett, wife of Stephen H. Hockett, and that wherever in this deed the name Hockett is spelled Hockett it is one and the same name as Hockett. I further state that Israel Compton in filling out the acknowledgement of this deed carelessly has written Stephen H. Hockett, but this refers to one and the same person as Stephen H. Hockett. The writing in this deed is quite poor but I am positive in my own mind that he intended to write Stephen H. Hockett all through the instrument. I further state I lived in the community of Earlham at the time the above described deed was made and I remember well that Stephen H. Hockett and Mary Hockett, his wife sold the land described in the above mentioned deed to Joseph William son.
