State of Iowa Madison County, SS. I, A.M. Rogers, being first duly sworn, on oath depose and say that I am a grand-son of James Rogers who was grantee in a certain Referees' Deed in which S.I. Gordon, Stephen C. Smith and George T. Darnall, as Referees, conveyed the W²/₃ of Lot 4 in Hutchings' Addition to Winterest, Iowa by Deed recorded February 18, 1878 in Town-
 Lot Deed Record 2, page 295; that I was well acquainted with the members of the family of James Rogers, my grand-father, and know that he died on or about the ---- day of August A.D. 1894, leaving the following named children as his heirs and only heirs at law, to-wit: Rose, a daughter, who intermarried with O.P. Anderson; Jahu Rogers, a son; E.C., a daughter, who inter-
 married with H.W. Mercer; Vina Rogers a daughter; William S. Rogers, a son; and E.H. Rogers, a son.
