State of Iowa, Madison County SS. We, W.A. Cook and L.E. Cook of lawful age of the County of Madison and State of Iowa being first duly sworn on oath, each for himself states as follows:-

That I was well and personally acquainted with Asenath George now deceased who was the surviving spouse of Evan George, deceased who died seized of the following described real estate, to-wit:- The West half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-three (23) Township Seventy-eight (78) North, Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the fifth P.M., in Dallas County, Iowa, (except commencing at the Southeast corner of said West half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, Township 78 North, Range 29, thence North 20 rods, thence West 20 rods, thence South 20 rods, thence East 20 rods to place of beginning; also Lots Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) in Block Six (6) of Academy addition to the town of Earlham, Iowa; also Lot Ten (10) in Block Three (3) of the original town of Earlham, Madison County, Iowa, in which the said Asenath George was given a life estate by the terms of the will of the said Evan George, deceased; that the said Asenath George is now deceased having departed this life at Earlham, Iowa on the 2 day of December A.D. 1917, intestate and leaving surviving her the following named persons, as her heirs at law, her only heirs at law and all her heirs at law, to-wit:- F.
