Johnson from and after this date; hereby waiving and setting over unto the said J.D. Johnson any and all claims that I may have in and to his wages, property or emoluments and I also hereby give notice to all parties that I will in no event be liable for any debts hereafter contracted by the said J.D. Johnson.
