State of Iowa Madison County SS.I., M.L.Silliman, of said county and state, being first duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with the Alonso W.Banker, to whom, through and by the last will and testament of L.Banker, deceased, father of the said Alonso W.Banker, which is recorded at page 37, of Will Record C, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, said will having been admitted to probate in said county on April 30th, 1901, was bequeathed the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M.
