State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, L. M. Tidrick, of said County and state being solemnly sworn on my oath depose and say that I have lived in Winterset, Iowa, and been engaged in the practice of medicine & surgery since the year 1850. That I was well and intimately acquainted with I. D. Guiberson for some years prior to his death that I knew him well when he was married to Elizabeth P. Knowlton, and that for some years prior to his death in the year 1858 the said I. D. Guiberson owned Lot one (1) in Block 16 in the original town of Winterset, Iowa, and he occupied said premises as his homestead with his family up to and at the time of his death in the year 1858. That after his death his surviving widow, Elizabeth P. Guiberson, afterwards Elizabeth P. Knowlton continued with her family to live upon and occupy said premises as her homestead & she never at any time had her dower in the estate of I. D. Guiberson admeasured or set off to her but she continued to live upon and occupy said premises as her homestead until her death about one year ago. That in the year 1862 she, the said Elizabeth P. Guiberson, married one William M. Knowlton with whom she lived until his death about fifteen or more years ago and that while she lived with said Knowlton they continued to live upon & occupy said property as a homestead. That I was intimately acquainted with all of said persons and have personal knowledge of all the statements hereinbefore made & they are each personally known to me to be true.
