State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, J.E.Hamilton of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Allen McClure, grantee in a certain Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "A", page 50 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 22-74-27, -and with Allen McLure, grantor in a certain Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Rec. "K", page 190 of said records, conveying to Henry Hollenshead 6 acres described as follows:-Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 22-74-27, running thence West 12 rods, thence South 80 rods, thence East 12 rods, thence N. 80 rods to the Place of Beginning, -and with Allen McLuer, grantor in a certain Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "M", page 359 of said records, conveying to Fredrick Beeler the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 22-74-27, and other land (said Allen McLuer's name appearing as Allen McCluer in the Conveying Clause of said deed), and with Allen McClure, who, together with his wife, executed a certain Warranty Deed to Fredrick Beeler which is recorded in Deed Record 10, page 247 of said records, and conveying the North part of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 22-74-27, containing 60 acres, and other land, and know of my own personal knowledge that said Allen McClure, Allen McLure, Allen McLuer and Allen McCluer as above mentioned are one and the same and identical person, his true and correct name being Allen McClure.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with Henry Hollenshead mentioned above as grantee (his name appearing in said deed as Henry Hollenshed) and know that he is the same and identical person as the Henry W. Hollinshead, who, together with his wife, executed a certain Quit Claim Deed conveying 6 acres in the Northeast corner of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 22-74-27, which deed is recorded in Deed Record 21, page 182, of said records.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with Joseph Gillespie, grantee in two certain Warranty Deeds, each dated Jan. 22-1881 and conveying the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 22-74-27 and one recorded in Deed Record 19, page 117 and the other in Deed Record 19, page 124 of said records, and know of my own personal knowledge that Joseph Gillespie above named was the same and identical person as the Joseph Gillaspie who, together with Mary Gillespie executed a certain Quit Claim Deed conveying said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 22-74-27, which deed is recorded in Deed Record 25, page 503 of said records.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with William Hole, who, together with his wife executed a conveyance of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 22-74-27 to Geo. A. Whitney, which is recorded in Deed Record 27, page 419 of said records (said William Hole's name appearing in said deed and in the acknowledgement thereto as William Hole) and with William Hole, grantee in a conveyance of said forty acres, which is recorded in Deed Record 27, page 117 of said records, and know that said William Hole and William Hole was one and the same person.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with Wm. Hole grantee in a conveyance of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 22-74-27 recorded in Deed Record 30, page 361 of said records and know that he is the same and identical person as the W.M. Hole, who, together his wife, executed a conveyance of said 40 acres recorded in Deed Record 30, page 404 of said records.

That I am well and personally acquainted with E. Hayden, grantee in a conveyance of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 22-74-27 recorded in Deed Record 32, page 66 of said records and know that he is the same and identical person as the Elijah Hayden who executed a conveyance of said 40 acres, his wife joining, which conveyance is recorded in Deed Record 44, page 296.

I further state that I am in no way interested in making this affidavit, or in the title to the land herein described, but make the same at the request of the present owner of a part of said land for the purpose of establishing of record the facts as herein stated.
