State of Iowa Polk County SS, I, George G. Hunter, being first duly sworn, state that I am the George G. Hunter who, as president of the Des Moines Fire Insurance Company, released a mortgage dated April 27, 1905 and given by Frank Glynn and wife, Laura Cecelia Glynn, to the Des Moines Insurance Company, which said mortgage covered the North Half (1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of Section 13-77-26, Madison County, Iowa, and is recorded in the Records of Madison County, Iowa, in Book 48 of Mortgages, page 34, said release being executed by me on November 5, 1908, and recorded in the Records of Madison County, Iowa, October 5, 1912, Mortgage Record 53, page 593.

I do further state that the Des Moines Insurance Company, by changing its Articles of Incorporation, changed the name thereof to Des Moines Fire Insurance Company, and such was the name of said company at the time of the execution of the above release, and that subsequently the Des Moines Fire Insurance Company was consolidated with the Hawkeye & Des Moines Fire Insurance Company, and that I am now Vice President of said company. That the above mortgage has been paid in full and that the release thereof recorded in the Records of Madison County, in Volume 53, page 593, was executed by authority of the Board of Directors of the Des Moines Fire Insurance Company, formerly the Des Moines Insurance Company.

All of which above statements are made from my own personal knowledge and are correct and true as I verily believe.
