I, M.L.Silliman, a resident of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the Thomas Glynn who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed dated January 29th, 1889, executed by John McLeod and wife, S.E. McLeod conveying the North Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., and recorded in Deed Record 27, at page 190, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as the Thomas Glynn, Jr., who is named as grantor in a certain warranty deed dated December 23rd, 1904, conveying to Frank Glynn the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township and range, said deed being recorded in Deed Record 47, at page 182, of the records of said county and as the Thomas Glynn, Jr., who is named as grantor in a certain warranty deed to Frank Glynn, dated April 24th, 1905, recorded in Deed Record 47, at page 272, of the records of said county, and conveying the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township and range.

I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the M.S. Howell who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed from Aaron Howell and wife, Margaret Howell, dated January 19th, 1878, recorded in Deed Record 16, at page 130, of the records of said county, and conveying the South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township and range, and with the M.S. Howell who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed from John Cunningham and wife, Catharine Cunningham, dated April 22nd, 1887, recorded in Deed Record 26, at page 272 of the Records of said county, and conveying a tract of land described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township and range, running thence North 48 rods, thence East 10 rods, thence South 48 rods,

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thence West 10 rods to the place of beginning; and well and personally know that the said N.S. Howell is one and the same identical person as the Nelson S. Howell who died intestate, on or about October 12th, 1908, seized in fee of said real estate, and whose estate was probated in Madison County, Iowa.

I further depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with the Della Howell Crossley who is named as mortgagee in a certain mortgage dated May 21st, 1913, made and executed by B.F. Howell and wife, Mary H. Howell, upon the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and ~~the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$)~~ of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section township and range, said mortgage being recorded in Mortgage Record 56, at page 270, of the records of said county, and well and personally know that she is the same and identical person as the Della H. James who, on November 12th, 1917, released and discharged said mortgage on the margin of the record thereof--- the said Della H. Howell Crossley having intermarried with one Oliver James subsequent to the date of the execution of above described mortgage.
