Dorrell, being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than 60 years last past and was well acquainted with George Arnolds who made the Original Entry on the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 77, Range 29 West of the 5th P. M. as shown by the Book of Original Entry now on file in the Office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa; and also with the George Arnold, Sen., who conveyed the above described land to Amelia Floyd, by Warranty Deed, dated June 24, 1867, which said deed was duly filed for record in the Office of the County Recorder of said County on the 15th day of June 1868, and duly recorded in Book "W" at page 74; and affiant positively knows that the said George Arnolds and the George Arnold, Sen., were one and the same person notwithstanding the discrepancy in names.

I was also well acquainted with the Mary Arnold who conveyed the above described real estate to Amelia Floyd by Quit Claim Deed dated the 8th day of November 1870, which said Deed was filed for record in the Office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on the 14th day of December 1870, and duly recorded in Deed Record "2" at page 556 of the records of said County, and I know that at the time she executed said deed she was the wife of George Arnold, Sen., and also that she was the wife of the said George Arnold, Sen., at the time he executed the deed above referred to, in which he conveyed this land to the same Grantee.

I was also acquainted with Amelia Floyd, the Grantee above referred to who was also the Grantee in a certain Quit Claim Deed dated Nov. 30, 1869, which said Deed was duly filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, and duly recorded in Deed Record "2" at page 233 of the Records of said County; and I also acquainted with Michael Floyd who was the Granter in said deed, which said Deed conveyed the land above described, and I know that at the time the said Michael Floyd executed said deed he was the husband of the said Amelia Floyd. Further affiant saith not.
