AN ORDINANCE, Vacating the ally in block eight (8), original plat of the town of Earlham, Iowa, and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to convey the same by quit claim deed to the Earlham Milling Co.

Be it ordained by the town council of the incorporated town of Earlham, Iowa:

Sec. 1. That the alley in block eight (8) original plat of said town be and the same hereby is vacated.

Sec. 2. That the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized to convey for said town said premises, by Quit Claim deed to the Earlham Milling Co.
