State of Iowa, Union County, SS. I, Charlton L. Reid, of said County and State, on oath say that I am the person who was grantee in a certain conveyance made by Joseph S. Dodd and wife Florence E. Dodd to Charlton L. Reid, dated February 14th, 1911, in which was conveyed to me the north half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section two (2) in township seventy-three (73) north, of range twenty eight (28) west of the 5th P.M. Iowa, and the South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-five (35), in Township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, in which conveyance it was recited that the premises were free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except incumbrance of nine thousand (9000) Dollars.

That in fact there was no one encumbrance on said premises of nine thousand (9000) dollars. That the nine thousand (9000) dollars incumbrance on said premises referred to in said conveyance consisted of one mortgage for five thousand (5000) dollars made by George W. Callison and wife to the Equitable Life Insurance Company of Iowa, dated on or about April 1, 1910; upon a part of said real estate; one mortgage for nineteen hundred (1900) dollars made by Joseph S. Dodd and wife Florence E. Dodd to George W. Callison, dated on or about March 15th 1910, upon a part of said real estate; one mortgage for two thousand (2000) dollars made by Asa Berry and wife Eva to F. E. Dufur, Cashier, dated on or about August 2nd, 1909, upon another part of said real estate; and one mortgage for one hundred (100) dollars made by Joseph S. Dodd and wife Florence E. Dodd to Asa Berry, dated on or about March 1st, 1910, upon the same real estate as described in the said mortgage for two thousand (2000) dollars; the aggregate amount of said Mortgages being nine thousand (9000) dollars.

That said mortgages were the only mortgages on said real estate at the time the same was conveyed to me; that they were each of record as I am informed and believe, and that about the first of March, A.D. 1915, I caused to be paid off of said mortgages, and that they were about that time or soon thereafter discharged of record.

That I am in no way interested in the subject matter of this affidavit at this time, except to establish the facts of record.
