Discharge of Bankrupt: District Court of the United States, Southern District of Iowa.  
 Whereas Mrs Addie St John of Des Moines, Iowa, in said district, has been duly adjudged a  
 bankrupt, under the Acts of Congress relating to bankruptcy, and appears to have conformed  
 to all the requirements of the law in that behalf, upon motion of C.O. Holly attorney for  
 said bankrupt, it is therefore <sup>ordered</sup> by this court that said Mrs Addie St John be discharged  
 from all debts and claims, which are made provable by said acts against her estate, and  
 which existed on the 11th day of July A.D. 1914, on which day the petition for adjudication  
 was filed by her excepting such debts as are by law excepted from the operation of a dis-  
 charge in bankruptcy. Witness the Honorable Martin J. Wade, Judge of said District Court, this
