I am personally acquainted with Addison J. Pemberton, who on or about May 29th, 1912, conveyed unto Ida S. Johnson the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) except that part which lies west of the main channel of Middle River, and all that part of the north half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) lying south and east of Middle River, and all that part of the southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) lying east of Middle River, all in section four (4) in township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty seven (27) west of the 5th P.M. Iowa, the deed being recorded in deed record fifty four (54) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 11 thereof, and that he was the same and identical man as A. J. Pemberton to whom Wilson E.
